## Film, TV, & Electronic Media Associates Degree for Transfer (AA-T) – 60 units

For students wishing to pursue a traditional film school course of study. This AA-T gives students a broad foundation in the art and practice of filmmaking in addition to general education courses. Qualifies students to transfer to a Bachelor's Degree program in TV, film, electronic arts or similar majors at a California State University.

#### Certificate in Film/TV Production Crafts – 20-25 units

• For students seeking to gain the skills necessary to apply to entry level positions in the film/TV industry including grip, lighting technician, camera utility/loader, set dresser, assistant editor and stagehand.


- This AA-T degree is meant to be transferable to a four-year college and is CSU transferable



## STAGEHANDS CRAFT PATHWAY

- Work Experience classes are repeatable and consist of:

    - 2. 54 minimum work experience hours required
- 2. FLM PRD 300 is prerequisite/corequisite for work experience classes
- 3. You can take more than one 901 or 911 within a semester. However, you CANNOT double count hours.
